

ITEMS FOR ADMISSION TO SCHOLZE CENTER

The following should be the only items brought with a child who is being admitted to the Scholze Center.

- Clothes for seven days only:
- Jeans, shorts for gym time, undergarments, shirts, pajamas etc.
- Clothing items should be plain, no advertisements, slogans, etc.
- 1 pair Tennis shoes
- 1 jacket
- 1 hoody
- Shower shoes/flip flops
- Deodorant
- Shampoo, conditioner and hair ties only, NO GEL, MOOSE, HAIR SPRAY, BLOW DRYERS, ECT
- Hair brush and or comb
- Soap or body wash
- Tooth paste and Tooth brush
- Laundry soap, No bleach or dryer sheets
- Stamps and envelops
- Paper
- Pencil NO PENS OR MARKERS OR HIGHLIGHTERS OF ANY KIND

ITEMS **NOT** TO BRING TO SCHOLZE CENTER

- musical instruments without the consent of their Primary Counselor
- personal radios, televisions, other electronic equipment
- lighters, tobacco products
- aerosol products (pump spays are acceptable)
- any preparations that contain alcohol (examples perfumes, cologne, after shave, mouth wash, nail polish, nail polish remover and the like). Such items must be given to the staff to be stored and returned to you or your parents/ responsible party prior to their leaving the facility.
- Games
- Outside reading material not approved by their Primary Counselor
- Cosmetics
- Food, gum or candy of any kind
- Jewelry, including watches, rings, ear rings, tongue rings and the like
- cameras or video equipment
